A list of firms selected for interview shall be sent to all firms that submitted information in response to the advertisement, prior to the date selected for the interviews. The purpose of the interviews shall be to provide such further information as may be required by the selection committee to fully acquaint itself with the relative qualifications of the several interested firms.
