PHASE 1 – CONTAINMENT STRUCTURE & UPLAND FILL CONTRACT FOR SC STATE PORTS AUTHORITY

The South Carolina State Ports Authority (SPA) anticipates that in early March 2008, plans & specifications for the construction of the "Phase 1 – Containment Structure & Upland Fill Contract", for the Charleston Naval Base Container Terminal, at the former Charleston Naval Complex site in North Charleston, SC, will be made available to qualified contractors by the SPA.

The Project Will Include clearing & grubbing, grading & excavation, drainage layer placement, wick drain installation, fill & surcharge embankment import & placement in the upland area of the project site, dredging, sheet pile & pipe pile wall installation in the tidelands, & placement of a rock berm in front of the wall in the tidelands area.

The Work Includes clearing & grubbing of approximately 77 acres; the import & placement of a drainage layer of approximately 20,000 cubic yards of contractor provided sand (fines content less than 5%); the import & placement of approximately

420,000 cubic yards of contractor provided fill & surcharge material (fines content less than 20%), the import & placement of approximately 1.5 million cubic yards of SPA provided material for fill & surcharge from Daniel Island, installation of approximately 10 million vertical lineal feet of wick drains; dredging of approximately 857,000 cubic yards of existing mud & marl material for the construction of the containment wall structure, dredging (contractor's option) from the navigation channel to the project site to allow access for floating construction equipment; construction of approximately 5000 feet of a steel pipe (approximately 36 inches diameter) & sheet pile wall containment structure; delivery & placement of approximately 600,000 tons of rock (including armor stone) for the rock berm; & surface & slope stabilization including silt fencing, seeding, mulching, & erosion control blankets.

The SPA Provided Material from Daniel Island is located at the southern end of the island in existing dredge disposal basins & must be transported to the project site via the water. This material may not be hauled over roads to the project site. The contractor shall be responsible for all required federal, state & local permits in order to transport this material via the water to the project site.

The Wall Containment Structure will be approximately 3,000 feet long across the front, which will include pipe piles & intermediate sheet piles. The front wall will be parallel to the federal channel in the Cooper River located approximately 850 feet from the existing shoreline into the river. The north & south side walls will include sheet piles & will extend from the front wall to the existing shoreline.
