The grant will assist in the development of
an approximately 0.9 mile walking, recrea-
tional, historical & interpretive trail. The
project is located along an old railroad bed
through the center of the Town of Spring-
field extending from the end of Festival Trail
Road to the end of Railroad Avenue at Ca-
mellia Lane. Activities approved for the
project include an asphalt trail which com-
plies with the American Disabilities Act
(ADA) standards. The grant also includes
landscaping, irrigation, new pedestrian light-
ing fixtures, & a water feature.
