REHABILITATION OF WOODROW WILSON FAMILY HOME

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

Historic Columbia Foundation, Inc. (HCF) invites Interested General Contractors who are qualified to perform restoration & rehabilitation of historic properties to submit statements of qualifications for the rehabilitation of the Woodrow Wilson Family Home, located in Columbia, South Carolina. It is HCF's intent to invite at least two qualified contractors to submit competitive bids for the first phase of the proposed work & to negotiate with the selected contractor for the completion of subsequent phases of the Work. Qualified firms will have at least five years experience installing, erecting, & assembling work similar in material, design, & extent to that indicated for this project, & a record of successful in-service performance of their work. The firm to be selected must employ personnel, including supervisory personnel, experienced & skilled in the processes & operations indicated.

The Woodrow Wilson Family Home Is Listed in the National Register of Historic Places for its architectural & historic significance. It is considered to have irreplaceable cultural, material, & aesthetic value. Acknowledging this value & significance, the selected contractor must agree to exercise special care during all phases of the work to ensure that the existing building, its details, materials, & finishes that are to remain are not damaged by the work being performed.

The Rehabilitation Of The Woodrow Wilson Family Home Will Make Possible compatible uses of the property as an historic site for public visitation & interpretation. The principal aim of the project is to accurately depict the form, features, & character of the property as it appeared at the time of the Wilson family's occupancy in the 1870s

by means of the removal of features from other periods in its history & the reconstruction of missing features from the family's period of occupancy. All work must conform to the Certificate of Design Approval for exterior changes, as issued by the City of Columbia Design / Development Review Commission, & any requirements stipulated by guidelines set forth in the Department of the Interior's Save America's Treasures grant. The contractor will cooperate with HCF in its educational programming during the construction process. Compliance with all Federal, State, & local laws, rules, & regulations, a bid guarantee equivalent to 5 percent of the bid price, a 100% performance bond & 100% payment bond will be required.

The First Phase Of The Project Is Funded in part by a Save America's Treasures grant & consists of the exterior rehabilitation of the existing historic wood frame dwelling structure. HCF anticipates a construction start date of April 6, 2009. The work includes, but is not limited to, structural repairs to wall & first floor framing; removal & replacement of wood siding to accomplish structural repairs or to repair deteriorated conditions; replacement of the existing asphalt shingle roof with new wood shingles & replacement of existing standing seam & flat seam metal roofing & flashings; replacement of built-in & hung gutters & downspouts; replacement of deteriorated wood balustrades; window & door repairs or replacement; removal of brick infill at foundation piers; repair of scored stucco parging; installation of new wood lattice at foundation openings; & exterior painting using historic colors.

Future Interior Work Includes new HVAC & fire suppression systems; repairs to ceiling joists; repointing of historic masonry; plaster repair & patching; removal of existing ceiling(s) & replacement with new veneer plaster ceiling(s); repairing & replacing slate hearths, mantels, & encaustic tile; repairing brick chimneys; wood flooring repairs; & interior painting using historic colors. Future exterior work includes installing new wood shutters; constructing a new wheelchair ramp to access the first floor of the historic structure; & rehabilitation of the garden landscape to achieve interpretive objectives & provide space for rental events. The proposed work also includes construction of a new wood frame accessory building containing two public restrooms & a catering prep kitchen.
