Description: Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) has committed to reducing the output of its greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions as part of its recently completed 20-year plan. ReWa is soliciting proposal packages from engineering firms interested in preparing an inventory of greenhouse gases for all facilities & organization activities as a first step towards this goal. The inventory will consider two

years of interest: 2000 & 2009 (current). It is anticipated that the greenhouse gas inventory will only include activities under the direct control of ReWa. Greenhouse gases produced as a result of the production, processing, manufacturing, & construction of materials, goods, equipment, & facilities prior to becoming the property of ReWa should not be considered.

General Scope of Work: Task 1 - Data Collection. Information shall be provided according to the proposed measuring protocol to provide guidance regarding organizational & operational boundaries. The selected firm shall then prepare & submit a comprehensive list of data necessary to complete the project. The firm shall work with ReWa staff to collect records that will allow the development of utility-wide carbon baselines which consist of the years 2000 & 2009. In cases where data is not available, the selected firm may be required to coordinate directly with suppliers to obtain the necessary records or calculate emissions based on the best available data. It is in ReWa's sole discretion to assess the feasibility of historical data collection & advise potential updates on years used as benchmark. The selected firm will then arrange the data categorically (e.g. by wastewater treatment plant, collection system, administrative building, etc.).

Task 2 - Calculation of GHG Emissions Baseline. The selected firm will prepare an inventory of GHG emissions for ReWa utilizing an agreed upon standard. The standard proposed to be used for this project shall be described in the firm's proposal. The method used shall provide ReWa with a manageable model that may be changed or edited by ReWa.

The consultant will document their protocol, including sources of emissions factors, assumptions & reliability estimates, in a Technical Memorandum (TM). The TM will also document the boundary conditions, sources covered, & GHG emissions summaries (expressed as Metric Tons, CO2 equivalents). An aggregate total GHG emissions ("carbon foot print") will also be provided to ReWa. Disaggregated GHG emission totals will be provided for each WWTP, the collection system as a whole, & a category

consisting of general elements or those otherwise unallocated to one of the prior areas
