Notice Is Hereby Given that The City of Spartanburg will receive sealed bids from interested parties in providing subsurface exploration for a replacement bridge along Fairforest Road over Fairforest Creek located within the City of Spartanburg.

Bids Are Invited Upon the several items & quantities of work as follows: The fee proposal is for subsurface exploration for the replacement of the existing older bridge which has wooden piers & a concrete deck, the subsurface exploration will be necessary for design of the new structure. The existing bridge is two lanes & currently open to traffic. The City anticipates the bridge will be replaced with a single span 90 to 100 foot long structure. The type & width of the bridge has not been determined at this time. The new structure will rest about 12 to 15 feet above the creek. The City expects the end bents will be supported by deep foundations (steel HP piles) with vertical loads on the order of 50 to 70 tons per pile & horizontal loads of about 6 to 10 tons per pile.
