At the discretion of the SCDOT & Horry County, the three (3) highest ranked consultants will be assigned to one of the following projects: Carolina Bays Parkway Extension (Bridge/Roadway/Concrete Pavement), SC 707 Widening (Bridge/Roadway), and Backgate Interchange (Bridge/Roadway).

Work Includes, But Is Not Limited To, construction management, construction engineering, inspection, sampling, testing, & construction survey verification to determine compliance with the contract requirements, plans & specifications. The consultant will provide services that conform to current state policy & practice of construction engineering including certification of personnel. For each project, the performance of the services will ensure that quality materials are being incorporated into the project, ensure that quality workmanship is utilized on the project, ensure that the work of the contractor is progressing in accordance with the proposed schedule, track time sensitive submittals, & ensure compliance with applicable state laws regarding environmental issues. Other tasks may be added as deemed necessary by the SCDOT.

In Consultant Selection, The SCDOT Will Consider & conduct a comparative ranking of the firms submitting based upon the following: experience, qualifications, & technical competence of the staff proposed for the type of work required (25%), past performance of the proposing firm and subconsultants proposed on similar type projects and/or ability to perform all aspects of services (25%), familiarity of proposed staff with SCDOT practices and procedures (15%), past performance in utilizing DBEs (5%), DBE utilization plan (5%), responsiveness to the Department, including the availability of key staff, and the ability to mobilize quickly and meet project schedules and current workloads (25%). Each proposal is required to indicate the amount of work expected to be paid, on a percentage basis, to each firm identified as providing a service in the proposal.
