Description of Project: The U.S. Department of Energy awarded a \$45 million grant to Clemson University to build & operate a dynamometer testing facility capable of full-scale, highly accelerated testing of next-generation wind turbine technology. The objective is to accelerate the development & deployment of new generation wind turbine technology to reduce the cost of energy delivered. The Basis of Design has been completed for the building & utility infrastructure.

The selected firm will provide full architectural & engineering services required to design, specify, construct & commission a Wind Turbine Drivetrain Test Facility (CU WTDTF) for highly accelerated testing of drivetrains for wind turbines up to 15MW. Construction of the project may be completed using the Construction Manager at Risk method. If the CM delivery method is used, the construction manager will be a separate firm from the A/E & selected under a separate advertisement. The CU WTDTF will be

built through modifications to Building 69 on the Charleston Naval Complex in North Charleston, SC. The 52,000 sq-ft warehouse facilities will be retrofitted to include two drivetrain test bays, overhead cranes for moving equipment, electrical & hydraulic support equipment for the test bays, & office & laboratory spaces for personnel & instrumentation. A short rail spur will be constructed to facilitate test article shipment by SC Public Railways. The selected firm will be responsible for coordinating with SC Public Railways for the constructing of the rail-spur & with SCE&G for delivery of the electrical power to the test facility. The test stand equipment is being designed, constructed, delivered, assembled & commissioned by Renk Test Systems Labeco. The data acquisition system is being designed, constructed, delivered, assembled & commissioned by the Savannah River National Laboratory. The selected firm will be responsible for coordinating with these key partners to fully integrate the equipment into the building infrastructure.

The facility will consist of two independent test rigs equipped with motor & gearbox drive systems equipped with blade force simulation capabilities to be supplied by a vendor already under contract. Rig #1 (15MW) will have the capability to apply dynamic loads to the main shaft of the test specimen, replicating forces & moments along three orthogonal axes thereby simulating actual blade forces experienced in the field. Rig #2 (7.5MW) will have the capability to apply static off-axis loads to the main shaft of the test specimen, replicating static forces & moments. The facility must be designed to allow a dynamic forcing capability to be added to the smaller test rig at a

later date.
