REPAIR OF RAVENEL'S RAILROAD DEPOT

REQUEST FOR BIDS

The Town Of Ravenel Is Seeking Bids from architecture firms to oversee the repair of Ravenel's Railroad Depot. The Depot is located at 5775 Highway 165 in Ravenel, South Carolina, & it was constructed in circa 1900. The Tax Map Number of the Depot site is 187-00-00-100. Any architecture firm that bids on the project must be pre-approved to handle the restoration of historic structures by the South Carolina Department of Archives & History, which can be reached at (803) 896-6104. Only qualified firms should submit bids.

On September 13, 2011, a vehicle ran into the southeast corner of the Depot, damaging floor joists, windows, siding, the foundation, etc. There are structural problems, the roof & building appear to have been compromised & the building may have shifted. Emergency stabilizing repairs were completed on the Depot on October 13, 2011.

The Bid Should Include The Total Cost for a structural damage assessment, preparing construction documents that take into consideration the historic nature of the building, drafting & having published an ad seeking a company to perform the repairs, working with the Town through the bidding & permitting process, & construction oversight through site visits. The selected architecture firm will also be responsible for advising contractors that if the bid is awarded to their firm, they must use only high quality materials, they will not be able to begin work until the matter is resolved with the State Insurance Fund, & that they must honor their contract pending receipt of the insurance funds. References for restoration work on historic structures should be provided along with the bid.
