AIRFIELD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT, PHASE 1

Laurens County, SC, Will Receive Sealed Bid Proposals for the Airfield Pavement Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1, at the Laurens County Airport, Laurens, SC, FAA A.I.P. No. 3-45-0036-011-2011/012-2012 until 2:00pm, local prevailing time, on Thursday, June 7, 2012. Bid proposals will be accepted & opened in the Laurens Council County Administrative Offices located at 3 Catherine St., Laurens, SC 29360. Bids will be publicly opened & read aloud. Bids received after the stated time or at locations other than that listed above will not be accepted.

Scope Of Work: The work generally involves airfield pavement rehabilitation for 3,899' long x 75' wide Runway 8-26, taxiway system & aircraft apron. The project will be bid with a base bid & three additive bids described as follows:

The Base Bid – Bid Scenario "A" work will generally consist of rehabilitation of Runway 8-26 & portions of Taxiways "A", "B", "C" & "D". Under this Bid Scenario the runway will receive a 5-inch Portland cement concrete overlay & taxiways will be rehabilitated with reclaimed base & a 4-inch asphalt surface. Associated work includes milled asphalt taxiway grade ties, pavement marking, shoulder grading & grassing, limited storm drainage modifications & vertical adjustment of runway & taxiway lights & guidance signs near the runway. The duration of Base Bid – Bid Scenario "A" shall be 32 contract days & 62 consecutive calendar days. Airfield will be closed.

The Base Bid – Bid Scenario "B" work will generally consist of rehabilitation Runway 8-26 & portions of Taxiways "A", "B", "C" & "D". Under this Bid Scenario the existing runway & taxiways pavements within Base Bid limits will be reclaimed & receive a 4-inch asphalt surface. Associated work includes milled asphalt taxiway grade tie-ins, pavement marking, shoulder grading & grassing, limited storm drainage modifications & vertical adjustment of runway & taxiway lights & guidance signs near the runway. The duration of Base Bid – Bid Scenario "B" shall be 47 contract days & 77 consecutive calendar days. Airfield will be closed.

Additive Bid No. 1 will include complete demolition of the existing aircraft parking apron & reconstruction with new base course & 4 inches of asphalt surface course. Associated work includes earthwork, the remainder of Taxiway "C" rehabilitation, milled asphalt grade tie-ins, pavement marking, aircraft tie-downs, pavement sealcoat, shoulder grading & grassing & vertical adjustment of taxiway edge lights. The Additive Bid No. 1 work shall be accomplished in the contract time specified for the Base Bid Scenario that is awarded.

Additive Bid No. 2 is the construction of a 152 feet long x 75 feet wide paved overrun on the Runway 26 end. The work shall be bid in two bid Scenarios. Bid Scenario "A" shall be 6-inch thick Portland cement concrete over crushed aggregate base. Bid Scenario "B" shall be 4-

inch asphalt surface over crushed aggregate base course. The approximate 13,000 cubic yards of embankment required for the new grading of the paved overrun will be obtained from an onsite borrow source. Associated work shall include marking, erosion control measures, topsoil & grassing. The Additive Bid No. 2 work shall be accomplished in the contract time specified for the Base Bid Scenario that is awarded.

Additive Bid No. 3 is the pavement rehabilitation of Taxiway "A" west of the aircraft apron & reconstruction of Taxiway No. 1. Taxiway "A" pavement, within the indicated limits, will be reclaimed & then receive 4 inches of asphalt surface course. Taxiway No. 1 will be demolished & reconstructed with base course & 2 inches of asphalt surface. The duration of Additive Bid No. 3 shall be 33 days & shall commence after the Base Bid work is complete.
