Representatives from Richland County and the Engineer will be present to discuss the work. Project Description: Upper Pine Lake is a portion of the drainage improvements / storm water pond associated with the Greengate Development in Richland County. The pond is located approximately nine miles northeast from downtown Columbia, South Carolina. The pond is approximately 1.5 acres with a water depth of approximately 3 to 4 feet. The Engineer has estimated the approximate sediment volume for the pond at 79,000 cubic feet. As part of maintenance for the pond, Richland County is requesting bids to remove the accumulated sediment, dewater, and then transport the sediment to the Richland County C&D landfill, a Type II landfill facility. To access the project area, the Bidder will use an existing access road from the adjacent Fire Station. Because the pond is located in a residential community, Richland County desires to minimize impact to the surrounding home owner's properties; therefore equipment will enter the pond at one access point to perform the clean-out activities.

Prior to clean-out activities, the Bidder will temporarily drain the pond to provide access for the equipment. The Bidder will use an existing outlet structure to lower the water level in the pond. Richland County has designated an area adjacent to the pond for the temporary stockpiling of the sediment for dewatering purposes. The area is partially wooded. It is Richland County's intent that the Bidder utilize space in this designated area that is devoid of trees and to clear less than a quarter acre. The Bidder will also maintain a 15-foot off-set from the edge of the pond to allow for filtering of the dewatering run-off and equipment access. Because the stockpile area is limited in surface area, the Bidder should anticipate that pond clean-out will be performed in at least two phases. Filtering of the stockpiles will be achieved by use of silt fence or Engineer's approved equivalent. Depending on the consistency of the pond bottom, the Bidder may need to utilize a combination of timber matting, corduroy, and/or geotextile to access areas of the pond. The access road may consist of a timber matting or corduroy surface with an underlying geotextile (if necessary) for additional support of equipment trafficking. Because the Bidder will only be accessing the pond in one area, temporary stockpiling of the sediment (double stacking/handling) within the pond should be anticipated. The double stacks will be located in the pond temporarily until they can be relocated to the temporary Phase stockpile area. Double stacks shall be moved to the Phase stockpile within 24 hours after excavation. The work requested for this project will be performed under Department of the Army Permit #2014-00195-6F. Bidder will complete work in accordance with the permit. A copy of the permit is included in this bid package for review.

Basis of Bid – The bid will be based on a lump sum price. All work on the project must be completed by July 31, 2015.
