The Town of Mount Pleasant will receive Bids for the development and redevelopment of timber walkway systems located at Shem Creek in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina. The project is the second phase of the Shem Creek Park construction which will enhance public water access, commercial shrimp boat berthing, and moorage for "day-trip" recreational boaters. The Town is requiring Contractors to be licensed as Marine Contractors for this project.
